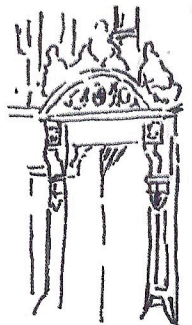
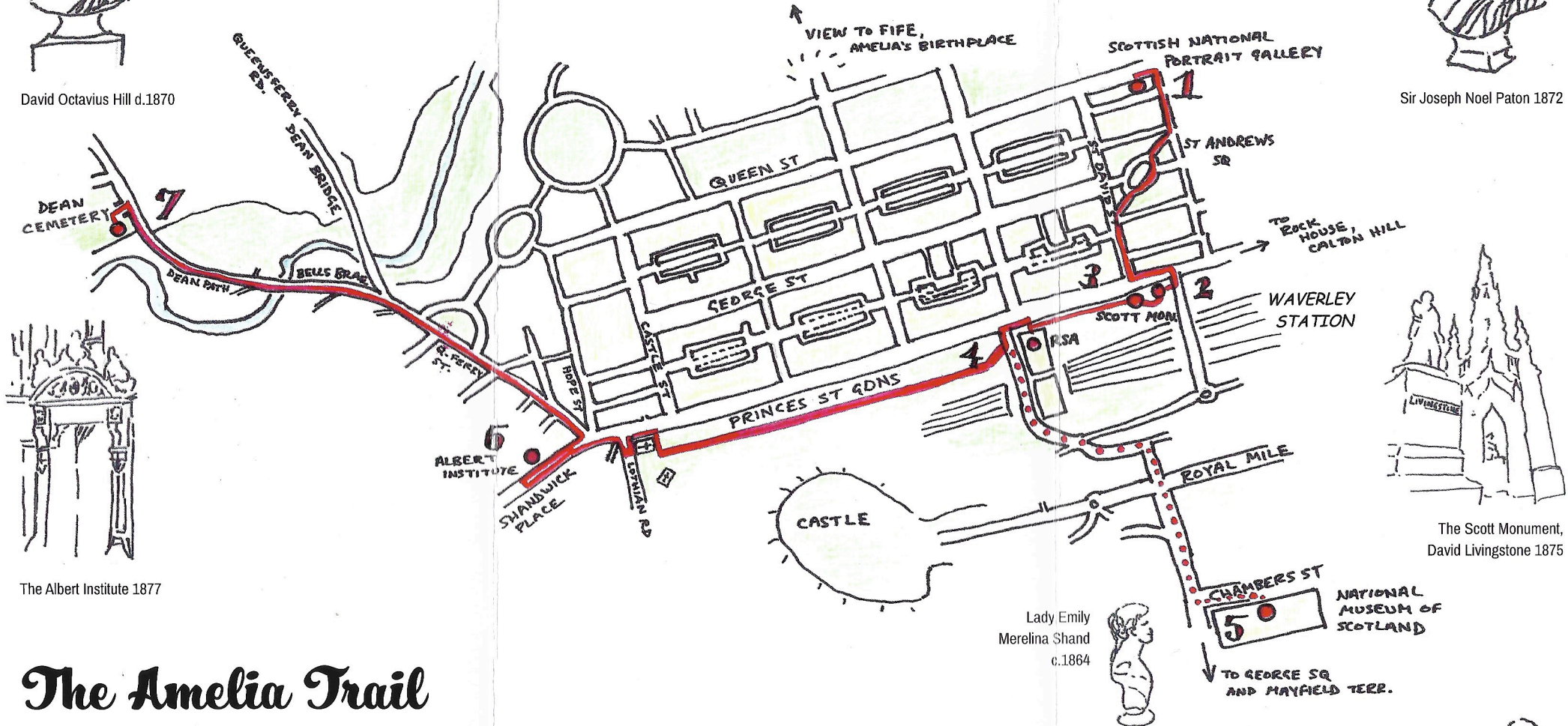




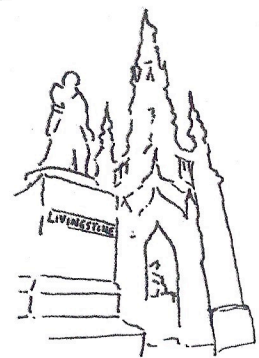

Statue	Location
1. Busts of artist Sir Joseph Noel Paton and photographer D.O. Hill	The Scottish National Portrait Gallery, Queen Street.
2. David Livingstone, physician, missionary and explorer	Princes Street Gardens, next to the Scott Monument.
3. Magnus Troil, Minna Troil and Richard the Lionheart	The Scott Monument: SW buttress upper tier, SW buttress lower tier, SE buttress upper tier.
4. Lady Emily M. Shand, wife of judge Alexander Burns Shand	The Royal Scottish Academy, Princes Street.
5. Hugh Miller, geologist and writer	The National Museum of Scotland, Chambers Street, Level 5.
6. 'Painting and Poetry'	Above the entrance to the former Albert Institute Building, Shandwick Place.
7. Bronze bust of husband David Octavius Hill	The final resting place of Amelia and D.O. Hill, on the left hand side as you enter Dean Cemetery.
